

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Fort Hall Business Council (FHBC) according to the Constitution of the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes (Tribes) has the responsibility to protect the general welfare of the Tribes and,

WHEREAS, there is a state of emergency declared within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Hall Reservation because of the current Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic and,

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 is creating a significant health risk to the Fort Hall community, now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUSINESS COUNCIL OF THE SHOSHONE-BANNOCK TRIBES, all residents of the Fort Hall Reservation who test positive for COVID-19, and all residents of the Fort Hall Reservation who may have been exposed to COVID-19 as identified by an appropriate investigative agency are to be quarantined (separated from others who have not tested positive or who have not been exposed to Covid19) at their normal place or residence; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, those individuals shall remain in quarantine (isolated from others) until they are medically released or do not show symptoms of the COVID-19 (fever, cough, or shortness of breath) for at least seventy-two (72) hours; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, any non-member found in violation of the quarantine requirements shall be guilty of a civil infraction fine. The first violation will be subject to a two-hundred and fifty dollar (\$250) fine. A second violation will be subject to a five hundred dollar (\$500) fine. Any subsequent violations will subject to a one thousand dollar (\$1,000) fine; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, any member of the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes found in violation of this quarantine shall forfeit their gaming per capita payment for one (1) year; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this quarantine become effective immediately and shall remain in effect until further notice.

Authority for the foregoing resolution is found in the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat., 984), as amended, and in the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes Constitution and Bylaws of the Fort Hall Reservation, as amended, including but not limited to the authority found in the Constitution, Article VI.


