Eligibility:

- Enrolled in a federally recognized tribe
- Have a permanent residence within 50 miles of the Shoshone-Bannock reservation
- Have a current GPA between 2.0-4.0
- Be enrolled in school or have employment
- Be between the ages of 13-24
- Have a completed application and **BE ALCOHOL AND DRUG FREE**
